足立区ジュニア吹奏楽団委嘱作品。2010年1月同団により初演されました。宮澤賢治の作品のイメージに曲をつけさせていただきました。移り行く季節の中で「おきなぐさ」が風に揺られ、空の雲をながめたり、ひばりと会話したり、最後は花が散つて魂が一つの小さい変光星になるというお話です（短い作品ですので是非読んで頂ければと思います）。曲は3部構成になっていて、風に揺られながら「おきなぐさ」がゆったりと歌う場面、ひばりが空高く舞い、声高らかに歌うテンポの早い場面、散つて行く「おきなぐさ」にひばりが寄り添ってゆったりと歌う場面からなっています。なるべく気取らない素朴な曲になるよう努めました。（福島弘和）

東京音楽大学卒業、同大学研究科修了、オーボエを、吉良憲裕氏、浜道晃氏、作曲を有馬礼子氏に師事する。1997年、吹奏楽曲「稲穂の波」で朝日作曲賞入選、1999年、吹奏楽曲「道祖神の詩」で朝日作曲賞を受賞し、全日本吹奏楽コンクール課題曲として広く演奏された。

2003年、吹奏楽曲「柳絮（りゅうじよ）の舞」で下谷賞優秀賞受賞。2007年吹奏楽曲「アイヌ民謡「イヨマンテ」の主題による変奏曲」で下谷奨励賞受賞。2001年度群馬県で行われた国民文化祭の吹奏楽創作曲を担当し「北からの風よ」が好評を博す。現在、オーケストラ、吹奏楽曲を中心に作編曲活動するかたわら、演奏にパフォーマンスやコメディーをとりいれた「アンサンブル・ポアール」を結成し、ユニークな演奏活動を行っている。
