●解説

秋田吹奏楽団創立 30 周年を記念して作曲され、2005 年同団第 27 回定期演奏会で初演された。

I. 童歌：「上を見れば虫っ子、中を見れば綿っ子、下を見れば雪っ子」というしんしんと雪が降る冬の情景を歌った秋田の童歌が楽器を替えながら演奏され、高音の金管木管の叫びの中で浮き沈みする。

II. 奏春：秋田にやってくる遅い春への喜びと、秋田市で古来から崇められている山である太平山に朝日が昇ってゆく情景がオーバーラップする。Eb テューバがようやくやってきた春への喜びを切々と歌い上げる。冬から春になる直前の夜明け前、ほのかに明るくなる太平山に小鳥がさえずり始める情景。そしてその喜びを全体合奏が紡いでゆく。

III. 鼓響：そして夏、笛の音、チャンチキ、竿燈祭りの祭囃子がバンドと絡み合い、テンションが最高に高まったところでわらべうたが全体に奏される。その後、曲はさらにテンポを上げ熱狂的に幕を閉じる。

今回収録に使用した楽譜は秋田市立土崎中学校吹奏楽部の委嘱により、小編成版に書き直し、なおかつ吹奏楽コンクール用にカットしているヴァージョンである。(天野正道)

●プロフィール：天野正道 Masamicz Amano

1957 年 1 月 26 日秋田市生まれ。1980 年国立音楽大学作曲科首席卒業、武岡賞受賞。1982 年同大学院作曲専攻創作科首席修了。在学中よりクラシック、現代音楽はもとよりジャズ、ロック、民族音楽から歌謡曲まで幅広い活動を始める。卒業後オーストラリアに赴き日本人で初めて C.M.I. (Computer Music Instruments) をマスターし、日本におけるコンピュータミュージックの第一人者の一人となる。その後、多くのアーティストのアルバム、映画、アニメ、ビデオの音楽、数多くの CM、TV の音楽制作をする。1992 年より続いているポーランド国立ワルシャワフィルハーモニックオーケストラで自作曲の録音、指揮、ワルシャワカルテット、トリオクラシックよりの委嘱、パデレフスキ博物館よりの委嘱、ミュンヘン国際音楽コンクール打楽器部門の作品やクリピンスキ国際クラリネットコンクールの課題曲を委嘱されるなど、活動の場は国外にも及んでいる。そのほか、MTV-JAPAN、題名のない音楽会などへの出演や、夜のヒットスタジオからの委嘱による作曲、演奏など軽音楽番組における作品の発表などジャンルを超えた活動を行っている。
