### ●解説

曲は「おきなぐさの歌」「ひばりの歌」「おきなぐさとひばりの歌」の3部構成になっていて、後半の「おきなぐさとひばりの歌」で2つの主題が交わる部分が自分の気に入っている所です。

この曲は2010年に足立ジュニア吹奏楽団の委嘱で純粋な吹奏楽曲として作った物を今回の企画に合わせくり返しなどを設定し、語りを入れてみました。（福島弘和）
